- 200-acre public parkland course original designer Robert Trent Jones Jr., calls "the Augusta of the North"
- Opened in 1982 as Jones' "Mona Lisa"
 - Reimagined in 2013–14 by Jones, Bruce Charlton, and Jay Blasi
 - Wisconsin's first SubAir system installed in 2020
- Signature par 3 16th—the Flower Hole—features 30,000 flowers
- Named Golf Digest's first-ever Best New Public Course

 Wisconsin Best in State

The field

- 156 professionals and amateurs from approximately 20 countries—including the U.S.—will compete for the most coveted championship in senior golf and the Francis D. Ouimet Memorial Trophy.
- Approximately half the field will be fully exempt into the championship through several categories—the other half will come from qualifying tournaments conducted at 30+ courses across the U.S.
- The championship is open to any professional or amateur golfer who is 50 years of age or older as of June 29, 2023. An amateur is eligible with a Handicap Index[®] not exceeding 3.4.
- In 2019, the USGA accepted entries from golfers in 48 U.S. states and the District of Columbia, as well as 32 foreign countries
